2. At what points do the experiences Paul recounts in 2 Corinthians 11. 16 – 29 recall events in Acts 13 and 14?

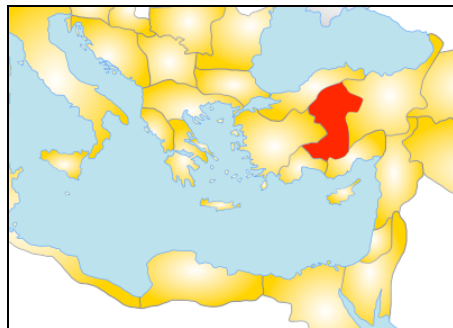
3. It is widely thought that the churches of Galatia to whom Paul addresses his epistle include those in Antioch, Iconium, Lystra, and Derbe. Read Galatians 1. 1 – 9 and 4. 8 – 20, and answer the following questions:

Under what circumstances does Paul say he first preached in Galatia?

Under what circumstances and for what purpose is Paul writing the epistle?
